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Abyssinia Missionary Baptist Church Opening Their Doors to the Community

Abyssinia Missionary Baptist Church, located in Cuyler Brownville at 1622 Ogeechee Road, has sold an empty lot next to the church to Savannah Historic Initiatives (SHI), affiliated with the Civis Foundation.

CHSA provided technical assistance for the property sale, which will result in four single family homes for sale to households with modest incomes. The terms of the sale also include the creation of a parking lot for the historic church, funded by SHI. Smith-Dixon says, "As a CDFI, we were delighted to bring together two entities with similar visions of community improvement. This is a perfect example of how CHSA brings housing opportunities to neighbors."

Abyssinia Missionary Baptist Church was established in 1911, and celebrates their 114th Anniversary this weekend. (The <u>Savannah Tribune</u> has <u>details</u>.) The church (**not included in the sale**) will remain as an important landmark and community center in Cuyler Brownville.

Rev. Brenda H. Allen was installed as Senior Pastor in 2020, and has forged strong ties with both church members and neighbors. She says, "I felt the Lord's calling to re-engage and connect with the community. Having new homeowners located right next to our Church will be an extension of our open doors to the whole community's restoration."

Abyssinia Missionary Baptist Church is a member of the Cuyler-Brownville Neighborhood Association, as well as the Berean Missionary Baptist Association. "Once we talked through the details with CHSA, it was easy to envision the way to connect the trustees and leadership of our Church with a developer who shared their commitment to making use of their resources to glorify God and build up the neighborhood," added Pastor Allen.



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

State and Local Housing Trust Funds: Critical Tools to Address Georgia's Housing Crisis!


